LEGAL GUARDIANSHIP

As this event does allow for people under the age of 18 to participate. Please ensure you take all precautions to ensure minors are supervised by a Legal Guardian at all times.

IMPORTANT LINKS

Touch Football Australia has developed a Responsibility Code. The code will be in place for this event. QTF expects all individuals to abide by the code, which can be viewed below.

The TFA Code of Conduct applies to all individuals and entities involved with TFA. This Code aims to ensure our core values, good reputation and positive behaviours and attitude are maintained and that everyone involved in our sport is aware of his or her legal and ethical rights and responsibilities. This code will be in place at this event.

EVACUATION PROCEDURE

Prior to an evacuation, the following ground announcement will be made over the PA System: "Ladies and Gentlemen, Management has requested that although you are in no immediate danger, for your safety we have to stop the game(s) temporarily and evacuate the fields. Please remain calm and move towards the evacuation point."

The appropriate evacuation process is:

- 1. After ground announcement (above), all staff/volunteers are to provide guidance and assistance to patrons if an evacuation is conducted.
- Patrons are to be evacuated to a safe area clear of problematic, damaged facilities or objects that could cause further harm.
- 3. A count of all patrons present should be conducted as soon as all are seated and reasonably calm.
- 4. Patrons and staff are to remain seated in the designated area, until Emergency Services have given the 'all clear'.

PLEASE NOTE: The evacuation point is located at the AFL fields. See event precinct map on page 14.

It is compulsory for the Nations Champions to check in all teams.

WHAT TO BRING

The following documentation is required to be lodged at your specified Tournament Check-In:

- · Any medical allowance requests (if required)
- · Final team list with playing shirt numbers (to be confirmed against the team list you provided via e-mail).

A team list report detailing the registered players and officials, and further information on how to input team numbers will be emailed to the Affiliate Manager. Please contact the team if you have not received this information prior to the event.

NOTE

- · New players cannot be added to the final team list (provided at Tournament Check-In) without being registered online prior.
- If a player who is not registered and listed on the final team list takes the field, the game will be forfeited.

Nation contacts are to confirm team lists and numbers at the official Tournament Check-In. At this time, a match ball and other information will be provided.

PARKING & TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

SPECTATOR & PARTICIPANT PARKING

Parking will be available within the venue. Please note the event site map which indicates parking locations. Traffic Management will be managing the car parking in the grassed area near the Coomera Rugby League Club. Please make sure you abide by all instructions and drive slowly throughout the venue.

Please note there will be another event taking place within the precinct and some parking locations are out of bounds for All Nations participants. Please drive carefully throughout the precinct as they will be pedestrians around.

DISABLED PARKING

Parking for those who require accessible parking will be situated near the entry into the venue off Beattie St. Please note you MUST contact the QTF office if you require a car park in this location and display your parking permit to the Parking Marshals on arrival.

We encourage all attendees to watch this wonderful cultural performance which will begin the event.







SCORE CARDS

Only registered players will be permitted to take the field.

It is the responsibility of each team to allocate the appropriate person to sign the score sheet at the end of each game (team manager and/or coach) to limit confusion and score disputes.

PLEASE NOTE

No junior player should sign the score sheet.

By signing the score sheet, the nominated person, on behalf of their team, has acknowledged and accepted the information on the score sheet to be correct, including:

- · Full time and half-time scores
- · Send offs or period of time sanctions

If you do not agree with the information on the score sheet, do not sign the score sheet and lodge a protest at the Athlete Services area – as outlined in the Conditions of Entry.



NOTE: this year you will be required to have completed a Team Score sheet which lists all Try's and Try scorers of the game. If you do not present this completed sheet to the Athlete Services desk, your protest will not be considered.

COMMUNICATION BETWEEN REFEREE & COACH

To prevent heated confrontations and/or the escalation of incidents occurring in the game, the Captain, Coach and/or Team Manager are encouraged to have respectful and ongoing communication prior to, during and at the completion of the game. This includes the answering of general questions only, however, does not permit the Captain, Coach and/or Team Manager to abuse and/or repeatedly question the Match Official(s).

If any communication between a Coach and/or Team Manager and Match Official(s) becomes aggressive and/or confrontational, communication between all parties is to cease immediately.

Referees are instructed to no longer engage with the player, coach, manager or official and will walk away from any possible confrontation reporting it to the QTF Referee Manager. Note: No person is permitted to approach a Match Official (Referee) after the game has concluded and the score sheet is signed. Similarly, no heated exchanges are to occur with Referee Coaches or other Event Official in the vicinity.

Breaches of the QTF Code of Behaviour will be referred to QTF Judiciary Panel. It may also lead to suspension and possible exclusion from the event, fines for both the individual and affiliate.

ALCOHOL & SMOKING

No alcohol is to be brought onto the premises and smoking is also not permitted. Section 6A of the Smoke-free Environment Act 2000 declares a number of outdoor public places smoke-free. Smoking is banned in spectator areas at public sports grounds and other recreational areas.

Penalties of up to \$550 apply to individuals who smoke in spectator areas at public sporting events. ALCOHOL & SMOKING

No alcohol is to be brought onto the premises and smoking is also not permitted. Section 6A of the Smoke-free Environment Act 2000 declares a number of outdoor public places smoke-free. Smoking is banned in spectator areas at public sports grounds and other recreational areas.
